# READING THE FOUR GOSPELS CHRONOLOGICALLY

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Reading the Bible alone is certainly a staple of our devotional life. Reading God's Word together with two or more people is like sharing a meal. It nourishes our spiritual horizons of God, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, and a greater gospel than we can envision alone. Reading together shapes our faith that leads to worship and gratitude.

The Bible gives us four biographers for Jesus' life: Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. The four Gospels tell a unique perspective of the parallel accounts of Jesus' ministry, death and resurrection.

Participants will engage in a chronological parallel reading of the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. The reading plan covers the varied perspectives of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John in chronological order to highlight their portrayals of the events surrounding the life of Jesus Christ.

Do bring a physical Bible, not a digital Bible. Be ready to thumb through the Four Gospels.
