



## REFORMATION AND THE CHRISTIAN FAITH

About five hundred years ago, a German monk named Martin Luther published a list of complaints against his church. This unleashed a series of events that shook the foundation of the church and split it into two main camps -- Catholicism and Protestantism.

The events, which we call the Reformation, still influenced who we are today as Protestants. The thoughts and actions of Luther and his fellow reformers shaped our relationship with God, how we read the Bible, how we deal with sin, our concept of the church, and our role within the wider society.

By exploring the history of the Reformation, our class this quarter will discuss the events that led to Catholic-Protestant split, how the reformers confronted crucial religious and societal issues through their lives and their writings, and how many important tenets of our faith and church practices came into being. We will use the lessons of the Reformation to help us reflect upon what the true salvation and the true church are.
